- Trailblazer, Community Service, and Asker A. Saeed Founder's Awards are presented to stellar South Asian lawyers and organizations with a record of supporting inclusion. The Asker A. Saeed Founder's Award was established in 2021 through the generous donation of Asker A. Saeed of Saeed Consulting Group, a SABAC founder.
- SABAC officially launched the **SABAC Endowed Fund** in 2014. The Fund was established in order to award scholarships to Connecticut area law students who have demonstrated a commitment to SABAC's mission, and to the South Asian community and culture, through their personal and professional accomplishments. One such scholar is honored at the Awards Dinner. **A portion of Gala dinner proceeds** are donated to the SABAC Endowed Fund.

2023 KEYNOTE SPEAKER Amandeep S. Sidhu

Attorney Sidhu is a co-founder of the Sikh Coalition, the largest civil and human rights non-profit organization in the United States dedicated to protecting the interests of the Sikh community. He has led lobbying efforts in the U.S. Congress regarding hate crimes, profiling, workplace, and public accommodation discrimination, and also serves as lead counsel in an ongoing effort to end the U.S. military's presumptive ban on the service of observant Sikhs and other religious minorities. In partnership with the Sikh Coalition and other organizational partners, Attorney Sidhu's work led to historic policy changes in the U.S. Army and U.S. Air Force that has opened the door to over 60 observant Sikhs serving in the U.S. military.

Attorney Sidhu previously clerked for the Chief Judge Walter S. Felton, Jr., of the Court of Appeals of Virginia and, while clerking, was a member of the National Association of Appellate Court Attorneys. At that time, he was appointed by Chief Justice Leroy R. Hassell Sr. in the Supreme Court of Virginia to serve as a task force member of the Commission on Virginia Courts in the 21st Century: To Benefit All, To Exclude None.

Attorney Sidhu is currently a litigation partner in the firm's D.C. office, focusing his practice on regulatory and compliance counseling, state and federal government investigations, and complex civil litigation involving regulated industries.
